To Our Valued Members:

Happy New Year 2025! As we step into this exciting new year, we hope you all had a wonderful holiday season filled with joy and relaxation. On behalf of the entire grounds crew and management team, I would like to extend our sincerest wishes for a prosperous and fulfilling year ahead.

We have a lot of exciting developments planned for 2025 that I am thrilled to share with you. Our commitment to maintaining the highest standards of quality for your golfing experience remains our top priority. Here are some of the initiatives and enhancements you can look forward to this year:

This year, we're excited to share several significant projects that are underway this winter/springtime to enhance the quality and playability of our course:

1. <u>Extensive Tree Work from Tee to Green</u> Over this winter, we will conduct a comprehensive tree management project throughout the course. This effort includes the removal of certain trees and pruning overhanging limbs that obstruct all golf shots. These changes are designed to improve the playability of each hole while fostering better turf health. By increasing sunlight penetration and airflow, we're ensuring a more robust and consistent playing surface.

2. <u>Rejuvenating Turf Areas with New Sod</u> Following the removal of some trees, we will be re-establishing sod in key areas to take advantage of improved sunlight exposure. This will result in lush, vibrant turf that enhances both the aesthetic appeal and overall playability of the course.

3. <u>Drainage Installation Around Greens</u> To address waterlogged areas around our newer greens, we are implementing improved drainage systems. These greens require more water to thrive, and the increased moisture has caused the surrounding perimeters to become overly saturated. The new drainage solutions will help maintain drier, firmer playing conditions around the greens, ensuring a better experience for all players.

#### 4. Irrigation System Upgrades

In February, we will begin a major project to replace irrigation valves and pipes at the #1 tee box. This will include work to install or replace piping under the cart path at the #1 tees. Due to the scale of this project, it is expected to take a couple of weeks to complete. Please note that during this time, there may be a detour near the #1 tee box and along the cart path. We ask for your patience and understanding as we navigate this necessary upgrade, which will improve water distribution and system reliability.

These are just a few of the improvements we are excited to share with you. Rest assured, we will continue to identify and implement additional projects throughout the year to enhance your overall experience at the course

#### 2025 Project Timeline & Events

- January-February: Completion of tree management and sod installation projects.
- March: Installation of drainage systems around greens. Preparation for the start of the season.
- April: (details forthcoming).

Please mark your calendars for these key dates. Additional updates and events will be communicated as the year progresses. #### Driving Range Balls on the Course:

**Reminder:** It is strictly prohibited to use driving range balls on the golf course. These balls are designed for practice and are often marked or colored differently for easy identification. **Proper Golf Attire:** 

#### While on the Course and Practice Facilities:

• **Men:** Collared shirts, tailored shorts or trousers, and golf shoes with soft spikes are required. Denim, cargo shorts, and athletic wear like gym shorts are not permitted.

• **Women:** Collared or mock-neck golf shirts, skirts, skorts, or shorts of appropriate length, and golf shoes with soft spikes. Tank tops, halter tops, and leggings without a skirt or shorts over them are not allowed.

• **General:** Hats must be worn with the bill forward. No tee shirts, tank tops, or overly casual attire.

• Why? Proper golf attire not only respects the traditions of the game but also ensures comfort and safety. It also maintains the aesthetic quality of our club, which is appreciated by everyone.

Action: If you arrive at the club without the appropriate attire, our pro shop is fully stocked with a range of golf outfits for both men and women. Our staff will be happy to assist in finding the right gear for your round.
